- as a corporate letterhead with motto
- as a corporate logo on corporate clothing
- items of jewellery including signet rings, and brooches
- medal boxes and other items of desk furniture featuring the RAAC or unit badges
- corporate name tags
- on any other item which is approved by HOC RAAC.

Permission is **not granted** for the use of the badge on any item associated with the promotion, sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages including bar mats, beer coasters and stubby holders.

I understand that state branches of the RAACA will continue to use the 'Frawley' badge which is not subject to these instructions. Unit Associations may use historical versions of unit badges as appropriate if approved by Unit Commanding Officers or Officers Commanding.
